The University Press of Mississippi is accepting applicants for the McRae Publishing Internship, generously supported by the Selby and Richard McRae Foundation, for the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters. This is a great opportunity for English majors or anyone interested in **book publishing**.

With the McRae Publishing Internship, the Press offers a singular educational opportunity to young men and women interested in book publishing to start their careers as interns and gain valuable practical knowledge about the publishing industry. Interns will learn about publishing while providing assistance to and working under the supervision of the Press's full-time staff in a variety of tasks:

- checking permissions
- assisting in the creation of book descriptions, and captions
- preparing email, spreadsheets, etc.
- maintaining multiple databases
- coordinating peer review

Summer interns should expect to work 40 hours/week for three months. Fall and spring interns should expect to work a minimum of 25 hours/week. The \$500 monthly stipend will vary based on the amount of time worked.

The McRae Internship is available each fall, spring, and summer semester, with the following deadlines for application:

Fall: July 30

Spring: November 10

Summer: April 10

This is a remote internship opportunity, and interns are required to use personal devices.
